### SORTING HAT / BANE

(30s-40s. Male. Any ethnicity but **especially interested in Bipoc actors**. Must be 6 feet or taller.) Among other responsibilities, this actor will play both 'Sorting Hat' & 'Bane'. Re: SORTING HAT. Personified in this story, he determines in which of the four school Houses each new student belongs. RE: BANE. A centaur who lives in the Forbidden Forest at Hogwarts. Must be comfortable with a heavily movement-oriented track AND must have huge upper body strength and be well-toned.

Everyone cast in this show is going to be part of the ensemble and asked to participate in all aspects of bringing the world to life. This will mean involvement in crowd scenes, moving of scenery and generally remaining active through a good deal of the show. As such, we are looking for people who are truly 'game' for this kind of creative experience.
